## Save Our 442 Bus Service



The loss of the 442 route around Leander Drive/Albion Street to Meadway is imminent. We ask everyone affected by this unfair decision to write to: The Manager, Rossendale Transport, Knowsley Road, Industrial Estate, Haslingden, BB4 4RS. We need you to express your strong opposition to this move. Only Parts of Meadway are likely to escape the withdrawal of the 442, which is to be re-routed around the Marland area.

**Councillor Peter Davison** said: *"I feel that Rossendale Transport is failing as a bus operator and I will be pushing the Greater Manchester Transport Authority to consider using another operator to take over this service."*

## Good News For Kirklee



At last there are proposals to replace broken fences, gates and many other works to improve the lives of residents on the estate. We are delighted to announce that the following work will be taking place:

- \* Provision of 1.0m high metal hoop top fencing & matching gates to the front gardens.
- \* Erection of 1.0m high timber divisional fencing between front gardens
- \* Creation of curtilage parking for houses along Alder Road and Kirklee Road
- \* Separation of communal pathways serving two dwellings to create individual gardens
- \* Refurbishing of existing handrails or provision of new ones, as necessary.
- \* Upgrading/replacement of internal front pathways where required
- \* Provision of 2.0m high steel palisade fencing to the sides of those properties located next to ginnels across the estate.
